

RESIDENT RESPITE AGREEMENT

This contract is entered on this _____ day of _____ 20__ Between resident _____ and _____ and shall be for a duration of no more than 14 days.

_____ is a licensed Assisted Living Facility licensed by the Agency for Health Care Administration as provided under F.S. 429, Part I and F.A.C. 58A-5.

_____ serves meals and snacks.

_____ holds a standard license to operate a resident capacity of 6 and cannot exceed the capacity for a respite resident. A respite resident will be counted to meeting the licensed capacity.

_____ is not an affiliate with any religious organization.

_____ is not a nursing home and therefore is not licensed to provide complex 24 hour nursing care.

_____ complies with admission meeting the regulatory requirements presented by the Department of Elder Affairs (DOEA). The DOEA rules are quite specific concerning who may be served by an ALF. In general, an ALF may serve anyone who is:

Eighteen years of age; Able to perform activities of daily living with supervision or assistance, if necessary; Free of communicable disease which is likely to be transmitted to other residents or staff. However, a person who is HIV positive and the facility can meet the resident's needs may be admitted if otherwise eligible; Capable of participating in social and leisure activities; Capable of taking his or her own medication with or without supervision by trained staff, or resident is capable of contracting with appropriately licensed third party to administer medications; Capable of self-preservation with assistance from staff in an emergency involving evacuation of the facility; Represented by a legal guardian if determined to be incapacitated pursuant to Chapter 744 F.S.

_____ may not admit a resident who is bedbound or have a resident remain in the facility who is bedbound for more than seven (7) consecutive days; Has a pressure sore or skin break classified as stage 2 in the standard facility setting; stage 2 can be admitted in an LNS under the conditions that there are orders of care from a health care provider; Stage 3 or 4 pressure sore cannot be admitted in any ALF; Requires 24 hour nursing care; Has special dietary needs which cannot be met by the facility; Is a danger to himself or others; Requires administration of medication, unless the medication is administered by a nurse or by a licensed third party contracted by the resident or the resident's legal guardian. Family and friends may not administer medications unless licensed or authorized to do so.
